Le Touessrok is on Trou d'Eau Douce bay, on the east coast of Mauritius, 50 minutes from the airport and the capital Port Louis. The resort includes Ile aux Cerfs, with its Bernhard Langer championship Golf Course, and Ilot Mangénie, an island retreat exclusive to guests, both a short ride by private boat.

Mauritius has two seasons: warm and rainy from December to April, and pleasantly cool and dry from May to November. Daily high temperatures range from 22°C (72°F) in winter to 31°C (88°F) in summer. Water temperatures vary between 22°C (72°F) and 27°C (81°F). The currency is the Mauritian rupee, divided into 100.

Accommodation

Rooms and suites are situated in the Hibiscus and Coral Wings, with further suites on the Frangipani Island. All are sea-facing. All guests have personalised 24-hour butler service.

Deluxe Rooms

31 Deluxe Rooms, Coral Wing (54 m² incl. balcony/terrace) 37 Deluxe Rooms, Hibiscus Wing (56 m² incl. balcony/terrace)

These have the latest in-room technology, contemporary furnishings, and expansive views of the Indian Ocean. They represent the more affordable level of luxury.

Junior Suites

33 Junior Suites, Hibiscus Wing (18 with king-size beds 65m², 14 with queen-size bed 70m² incl. balcony/terrace) 92 Junior Suites, Frangipani Island (72 with king-size beds 65m², 20 with queen-size beds 70m² incl. balcony/terrace)

These suites are modern, cool and contemporary with design features inspired by the tropics. Huge bay windows bring a changing light to the rooms as the day progresses.

Frangipani Junior Suites feature designer style, with plasma screen TVs and egg-shaped baths. Hibiscus Junior Suites are more classical in style.

Ocean Suites

6 Ocean Suites (126m² incl. balcony/terrace)

Light and spacious, Ocean Suites have a cool and contemporary feel, with separate lounge, private dining room and two secluded terraces leading off the master bedroom. They may interconnect to an adjacent Junior Suite; perfect for families.

The Royal Suite

(320m² incl. terrace)

For a level of service and luxury that was once reserved only for royalty, The Royal Suite has a huge master bedroom, dining room and outside terrace. It is completely detached for exceptional privacy, equally suited for entertaining in royal style or for a romantic dinner.

Villas

3 Villas (423 m² incl. terrace)

Here is supreme three-bedroom luxury, with private swimming pools, gardens and separate entrances, designed and furnished in cool, contemporary interpretations of Mauritian style. The living areas are light and relaxed, with high, vaulted wood ceilings. Villas have very latest technology multimedia entertainment and business systems. Each has two master king bedrooms, with a third queen bedroom behind. Bathrooms have stone bathtubs and lead out to private walled gardens with outdoor waterfall showers and daybeds. The villas are prepared to the personal preferences of guests.

Restaurants and bars

The mainland

Three-Nine-Eight

The main dining room on three different levels presents cuisines of nine countries in a 'culinary theatre' of eight show kitchens. These include a continental rotisserie and grill, contemporary Asian and Italian corners, an extensive salad bar, a centrally located patisserie section and bakery. Open for breakfast (7.30 to 10.30am) and dinner (7 to 10pm).

Barlen's

On the shore of Trou d'Eau Douce bay, this restaurant and bar is built from wood and thatch with an Asian-inspired interior. The relaxed menu includes sushi, Western chargrills, Japanese grills and salads. Open for lunch and dinner. Closed on Sunday evenings.

Safran

This enchanting restaurant presents modern interpretations of classic Indian cuisine. The focal point is the open kitchen with tandoori ovens producing varieties of Indian bread, appetisers and main courses. Open for dinner only (7 to 10pm). Closed on Wednesdays.

Sega Bar

Situated in the middle of the main pool, serving light refreshments, tropical cocktails and a wide variety of whiskies.

Beach Service

Light snacks and refreshing beverages are served on the beach. Available all day (7.30am to sunset).

Ile aux Cerfs

Paul et Virginie & Sands Bar

During a day of watersports or relaxing on the beach, lunch is provided by Paul et Virginie, a barefoot restaurant serving lightly grilled, fried or steamed local fish, seafood, pizzas and simple Mauritian dishes like palm-heart salad. Open lunch and afternoon (12pm to 3pm).

Sands Bar serves a selection of drinks, light lunch dishes and snacks. Open (9am to 5pm).

Golf Club Restaurant & Bar

The restaurant and bar offers panoramic views of the course, the ocean and the distant mountains of Mauritius. It specialises in fresh fish and seafood as well as delightful Mauritian dishes. Open all day (7am to sunset).

Ilot Mangénie

Crusoe's Restaurant & Robinson's Bar

On this romantic 'desert island', Crusoe's offers wonderful fresh fish, a salad bar and pizzas. On Sunday, there is a fabulous Mauritian buffet of spit-roasted lamb and chicken, Asian stir-fries, lagoon seafood and a tempting dessert counter, accompanied by free flowing sparkling wine. Open for lunch (12am to 3pm).

Robinson's Bar is the place to taste a selection of home-made rums served by Mr Robinson himself, friendly Governor of Ilot Mangénie. Open daytime (10am to 4pm).

Health and beauty

Givenchy Spa

The Givenchy Spa is a temple dedicated to beauty, health and serenity using special Givenchy products developed by LVMH Group laboratories. Treatments are provided by expert masseurs and masseuses selected and highly trained by Givenchy. Open daily (8.30am to 8.30pm).

Hairdressing Salon

The Hairdressing Salon provides services and care of the highest standards in hair aesthetics for both men and women. Open daily (10am to 8pm).

Sports and leisure

Fitness Centre

The Fitness Centre provides sophisticated personal training, stretching sessions,

programmes for swimming, aquatic exercise, tennis and golf. A jogging partner is also available on request. Use of equipment is free of charge, with a fee for personal trainer services. Open daily (7am to 8pm).

Land Sports

The tennis club, with four floodlit courts, is affiliated to the Peter Burwash Institute. The resort has bocceball, jogging track, volleyball, aqua-gym lessons, archery, badminton, football, yoga and tai-chi. Further afield there are nature trails and cycling.

Ile aux Cerfs

Golf

Le Touessrok Golf Course is an 18-hole par-72 championship golf course designed by Bernhard Langer. There is also a Golf Academy, which offers a state-of-the-art teaching and practice facility.

Water Sports complimentary

Facilities include canoes, kayaks, laser sailing dinghies, sailing boats, pedal boats, glass-bottom boat trips, snorkelling, unlimited water-skiing and windsurfing.

Water Sports non-complimentary

Scuba diving (PADI and CMAS), deep-sea fishing, parasailing, banana and tube rides, catamaran sailing and canoeing.

Kids and teens

'T-Club' is free for all children from 4-11 years. In its own large and well-equipped clubhouse, it provides exciting and

imaginative fun programmes and activities. Children can enjoy golf, tennis, windsurfing and swimming clinics. There are also excursions with a focus on educational enrichment. Dinnertime is always a special occasion with a wide selection of menus. Babysitters – available at extra charge – are required for children of 2 and 3 years, unless accompanied by a parent. Open daily (10am-10pm).

The teen's club is free to 12-17 year-olds. They can meet new friends from around the world in a safe and fun environment and enjoy activities including sports, excursions, outings, discos and theme evenings.

Conferences and meetings

The Orchid Room and the Jasmine Room each accommodate up to 100 people seated theatre-style or 60 people classroom-style and can be partitioned for breakaway meetings. The Jasmine Room is situated above the Orchid Room.
